## 2.1 REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

The application for poster presentation(s) must be submitted by uploading a one-page PDF abstract to the following website for Abstract Submission.

## 2.2 FORMAT AND NOTES FOR ABSTRACT

- You can download the Word file template from the Online Submission Form. Prepare the abstract on a one-page A4-size document, following the format outlined on the next page.
- •Do not include confidential data/results.
- ·List up to three keywords.
- •We only accept PDF files, which will be printed as submitted. (Color diagrams are permitted.)
- •The abstract will be published only in PDF, and will be posted on the IMR Lecture Meeting website.

### 2.3 View/Edit/Change of Submitted Abstracts

You can modify your registration using the submission form before the deadline. You may replace your previous abstract up to one time using the same form. Please contact IMR lecture office, if you intend to replace your abstract more than once or withdraw (cancel) your application.

### 2.4 POSTER SESSION

- -Poster presenter will be given a one-minute Poster Preview. Details of the Poster Presentation/Session will be available in due course.
- Please do not include confidential data/results, because the audience for the lecture will come from outside the university.
